Hello parents! You can now enrol your child in a free programming course at the National Museum of Science and Technology during the autumn holiday or Christmas holiday. We also provide transport to and from the museum, free of charge.

This autumn we are launching the National Museum of Science and Technology's programming tour for schoolchildren in classes 4-6 in Stockholm. We will visit your child's school and together experiment with and be inspired by the opportunities of new technology.

Developing your programming skills requires practice. Just like football or dancing. The National Museum of Science and Technology has therefore decided to focus on programming during school holidays and is now able to offer free holiday activities for your child. We also help with picking up and dropping off children, since we know that it can be tricky to get to the museum. A bus picks your child up from his or her school.

Is your child interested in continuing programming with us? And learning to make games using the coding language Scratch? If so, we have holiday courses during the autumn holiday, 30 October to 2 November and during the Christmas holiday from 2 January to 4 January.
